US 5 (3.75 mm) – 16/24/32” / 40/60/80 cm long circular needle (the optimal length depends on the size you’re working) and dpns in the smaller size if you prefer to work the sleeves with them. Adjust needle size if necessary to obtain the right gauge.

Gauge

24 sts x 29 rnds = 4 x 4” / 10 x 10 cm in stockinette stitch and color work, worked in the round (after blocking).

Other

4 stitch markers, tapestry needle.

Thistle (cardigan)

Thistle is a boxy cardigan with colourwork all over. The cardigan is worked seamlessly top down. It has long sleeves, a boxy shape with no waist shaping and the shoulders are shaped with short rows. The cardigan is worked in the round and both the front and the armholes are cut open once the body is finished.

Size

XXS-XS-S [M-L-XL] 2XL-3XL-4XL-5XL

This cardigan is meant to be worn with positive ease. Choose a size with approx. 6” / 15 cm positive ease at bust circumference.

Yarn

Tukuwool Fingering (100% Finnish wool, 2-ply, 195 m / 50 g), or other fingering weight yarn. Shown in colours Runo (C1), Selja (C2) and Sake (C3).

4-4-4 [5-5-6] 6-7-7-8 skeins of C1, 2-2-3 [3-3-3] 4-4-4-5 skeins of C2 and 1-1-1 [1-1-1] 2-2-2-2 skeins of C3.

Yardage

C1: 700-740-790 [890-1000-1090] 1230-1300-1455-1595 yds / 640-675-720 [815-915-995] 1120-1190-1330-1455 m,

C2: 390-410-435 [495-555-600] 680-720-805-880 yds / 355-375-400 [450-505-550] 620-660-735-805 m, C3:

130-135-145 [165-185-200] 225-240-270-295 yds / 120-125-135 [150-170-185] 205-220-245-270 m.

Needles

US 3 (3.25 mm), US 4 (3.5 mm) and US 5 (3.75 mm) – 40” / 100 cm long circular needles and dpns in the biggest size if you prefer to work the sleeves with them. Adjust needle size if necessary to obtain the right gauge.

Gauge

20 sts x 28 rnds = 4 x 4” / 10 x 10 cm in colourwork worked in the round on US 4 (3.5 mm) needles (after blocking).

Other

6 stitch markers, scrap yarn, E-4 (3.5 mm) crochet hook, tapestry needle.

Weightless (sweater)

Weightless sweater is worked top down seamlessly. The sweater has a round yoke with a delicate feather pattern. The sweater has long sleeves and the body is boxy with no waist shaping. The neckline, cuffs and hem are finished off with garter stitch.

Size

XXS-XS-S-M1 [M2-L1-L2-XL] 2XL-3XL-4XL-5XL

This sweater is meant to be worn with positive ease. Choose a size with approx. 6” / 15 cm positive ease at bust circumference.

Yarn

Ocean by the Sea Quill (100% Falkland, 495 m / 100 g) and Frida Fuchs Mini Fuchse Sock (75% BFL, 25% nylon, 85 m / 20 g), or other light fingering weight yarn. Shown in colors Pearla (MC) and Schiefer (CC).

2-3-3-3 [3-3-3-3] 4-4-4-5 skeins of MC and 2-2-2-2 [3-3-3-3] 3-4-4-5 mini skeins of CC.

Yardage

MC: 1060-1135-1200-1260 [1355-1420-1480-1605] 1790-1895-2090-2300 yds / 970-1035-1100-1150

[1240-1295-1350-1465] 1635-1735-1910-2105 m,

Needles

US 2½ (3 mm) and US 3 (3.25 mm) – 40” / 100 cm long circular needles and dpns in the larger size if you prefer to work the sleeves with them. Adjust needle size if necessary to obtain the right gauge.

Gauge

28 sts x 35 rnds = 4 x 4” / 10 x 10 cm in stockinette stitch, worked in the round on the bigger needle (after blocking).

Other

4 stitch markers, tapestry needle.

Woodland (cardigan)

Woodland is a sweet, oversized cardigan with the cutest little woodland colourwork at the hem. The cardigan is worked seamlessly top down. It has long sleeves, a boxy shape with no waist shaping and the shoulders are shaped with short

rows. The pattern comes with instructions for an optional bust dart. The body of the cardigan is worked in the round and cut open once finished. The pattern can be very easily modified into a pullover by omitting the steek.

Size

XXS-XS-S-M1 [M2-L1-L2-XL] 2XL-3XL-4XL-5XL

This cardigan is meant to be worn with positive ease. Choose a size with approx. 8" / 20 cm positive ease at bust circumference.

Yarn

G-uld New Zealandsk Lammeuld (100% non-superwash wool, 2-ply, 450 m / 100 g), or other light fingering weight yarn. Shown in colours Ufarvet - NZLg2 (MC) and Lyng (CC).

2-2-2-3 [3-3-3-3] 3-4-4-4 skeins of MC, 1-1-1-1 [1-1-1-1] 1-1-2-2 skeins of CC.

Yardage

MC: 840-900-960-1005 [1080-1130-1200-1310] 1455-1570-1770-1910 yds / 765-820-880-920 [990-1035-1095-1195] 1330-1435-1620-1750 m,

CC: 265-280-290-310 [320-335-350-375] 405-425-455-490 yds / 275-285-300-320 [330-345-360-385] 420-440-470-505 m.

Needles

US 2½ (3 mm) and US 3 (3.25 mm) – 40" / 100 cm long circular needles and dpns in the smaller size if you prefer to work the sleeves with them. Adjust needle size if necessary to obtain the right gauge.

Gauge

24 sts x 32 rnds = 4 x 4" / 10x10 cm in colourwork, worked in the round on the bigger needles (after blocking).

24 sts x 35 rnds = 4 x 4" / 10x10 cm in stockinette stitch worked in the round on the smaller needles (after blocking).

Other

4 stitch markers, scrap yarn, E-4 (3.5 mm) crochet hook, tapestry needle, 7–8 buttons (0.5" / 1.4 cm diameter), 2 spare circular needles in the smaller size, or smaller than that.
